Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing for these proposed rules will be conducted on May 11, 2020, at 9:00 AM Eastern at the offices of OAQDA, 50 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215 or can be accessible remotely by teleconference using phone number: (425) 436-6316 and access code: 328119. If the Amended Stay at Home Order issued by Ohio Director of Health Amy Acton on April 2, 2020 is extended through the date of this public hearing, then the hearing will be conducted solely by teleconference as authorized by Section 12 of Am Sub. H.B. No. 197 of the 133rd General Assembly.

On the date and at the time and place designated in this notice, all interested persons are entitled to participate or be represented and give their oral or written comments on the proposed rule-making. Please note that if the Amended Stay at Home Order has expired or is rescinded and the hearing is held in-person, the Authority will observe all social distancing recommendations or orders of the Director of Health then in effect and so hearing room capacity may be limited.

To facilitate scheduling of oral presentations, persons intending to give oral comments at the hearing should ensure that OAQDA receives notice of such intent by close of business (5:00 PM Eastern) on May 8, 2020 by sending notice of intention to provide oral comment to publiccomment@aqda.state.oh.us. Persons who provide OAQDA prior notice will be heard ahead of persons who register after the deadline or on the day of hearing. OAQDA reserves the right to impose reasonable measures, including time limitation depending upon number of persons testifying, to ensure orderly presentation of testimony at the hearing.

Interested persons may submit written comments on the proposed rules by mailing them to Ohio Air Quality Development Authority, 50 West Broad Street, Suite 1118, Columbus, Ohio 43215, or by email at publiccomment@aqda.state.oh.us. To ensure that written comments sent by mail or email are considered as part of the hearing record, they must be received by OAQDA prior to 5:00 PM Eastern on May 11, 2020.
